

Burston School Strike Centenary Appeal 1914 to 2014



At the last meeting of SERTUC's East of England Trade Union Network it was agreed to launch a joint Centenary Appeal to support the fabric of the Strike School Museum with an initial target of raising £5,000 by the annual Rally on Sunday 7 September.

PCS kicked off that appeal with a £500 donation at the 1st April celebration at the Strike School.

The Trustees were asked to provide examples of projects that they would like to/need to fund, these include:

- Funding the stone mason's restoration of the carved stone on the front of the Strike School
- Funding a re-print of Tom Higdon's pamphlet
- Signage on main roads to attract visitors
- Funding showing the BBC *Burston Rebellion* film at sites in the region (including Congress House)
